

## EZReader Capture Application

The Capture application, available from the CenterBar and Camera Toolbar, allows a user to select a rectangular area of the screen and place that image on the clipboard.

Once Capture is started, the user clicks the upper-left and then the lower-right points which define the area to be captured.

These icons are used to identify capture actions:



**Capture**

**Convert**

**Capture+**

**Capture** enables selecting the area of the screen, which is then placed on the clipboard

1. Click the capture icon
2. Click on the screen upper-left of the area to be captured
3. Click on the screen lower-right of the area to be captured.

The captured area is now available on the clipboard as an image.

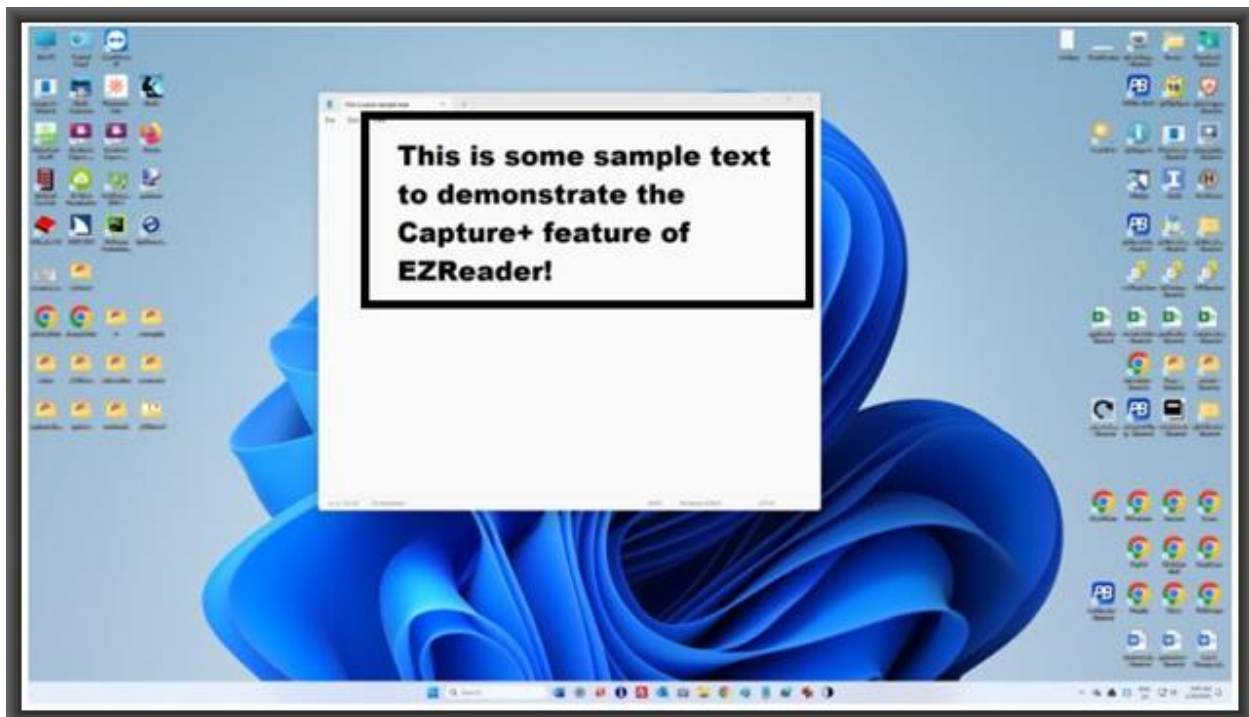
**Convert** extracts text from the clipboard image, displaying the results in the TextViewer application.

**Capture+** combines both the capture and text extraction actions.

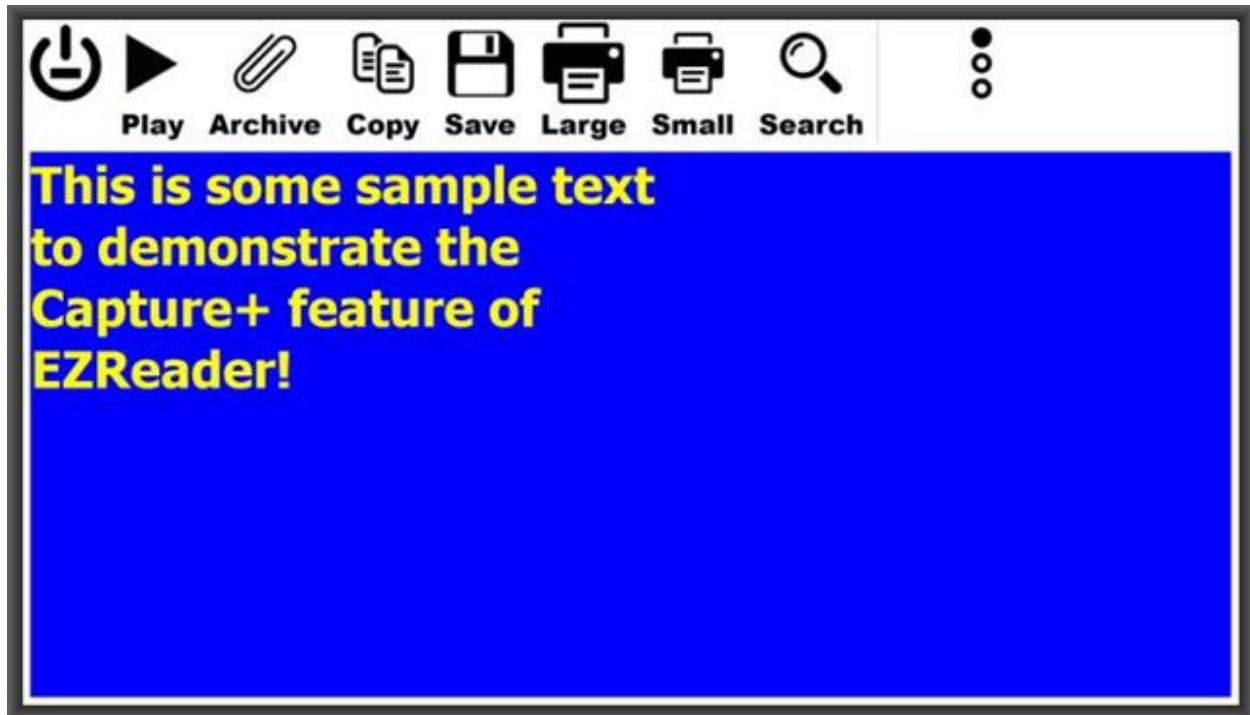
When Convert or Capture+ are executed, the extracted text is shown in the TextViewer application:

### Capture Result

When a capture is initiated, the entire PC screen freezes, allowing the user to select the upper-left and lower-right corners of the area to be captured. After selection of the two points, Capture+ will draw an outline around the selected text, as shown in this next image.



After the capture is complete, the screen is unfrozen, available for normal user actions. The extracted text is shown in the EZReader Text Viewer, as seen in this next image.



Note that the EZReader Capture+ feature does NOT require dragging the mouse. It is a touch-operation.
