

## **EZReader Jukebox Application**

The JukeBox application plays sound and music files. A small selection of music is distributed with EZReader. Users may add music files of their own. Sound files received by the EZReader Email clients are automatically copied to the JukeBox "Other" folder. The EZReader Import application can also be used to import sound files from a flash drive to the JukeBox "Other" folder.

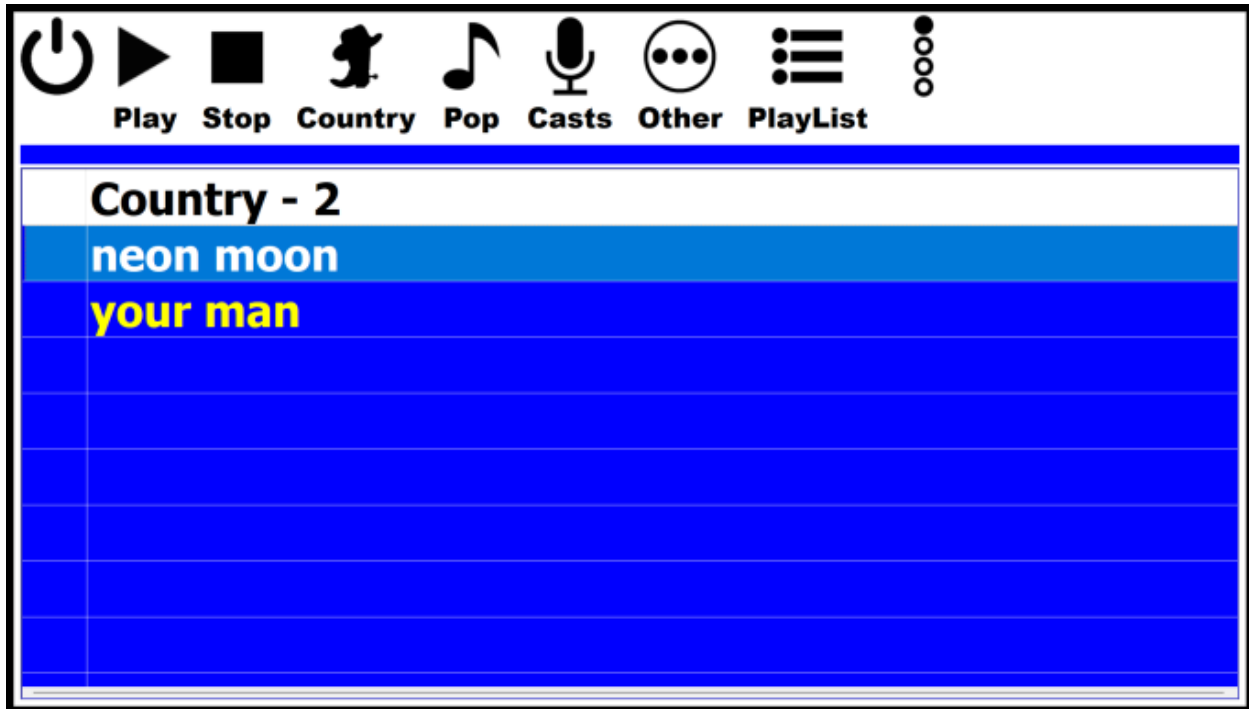
Music files are kept in 4 folders (Country, Pop, PodCasts and Other). A playlist of songs may be created for playing selected songs from those folders.

To play a song, just click on the song name and press the Play icon. Play, pause and stop action are supported. Double-clicking on a single title will also play the song.

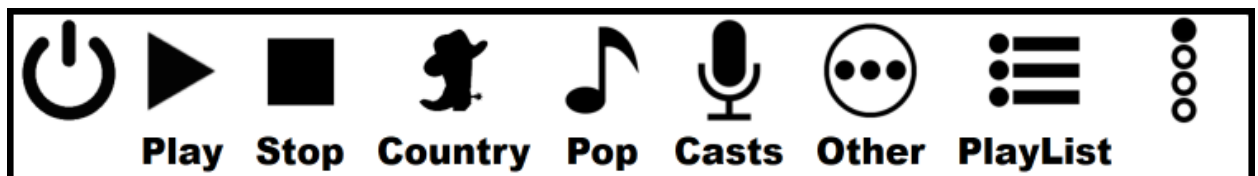
Each song can be "checked", meaning placing an X in the first column. This is done by clicking on the first column of the song. Play will loop repeatedly through all checked songs. The Delete function also works on checked songs.

As a song plays, a progress bar is displayed just below the toolbar. Click on the progress bar to jump to a specific location in the song.

A PlayList is supported. When a song is added to the PlayList, a copy of the song is placed in the PlayList folder. Songs in the PlayList folder can be deleted.



**Toolbar Commands:** Chat has four rows of command icons:



**Play:** Play the selected sound file

**Stop:** Stop playing

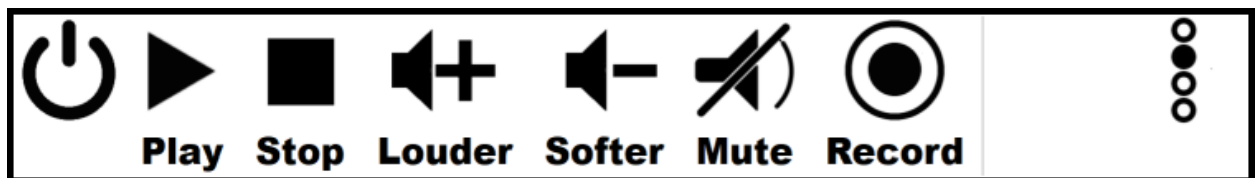
**Country:** Display a list of Country sound files

**Pop:** Display a list of Pop sound files

**Casts:** Display a list of PodCast sound files

**Other:** Display a list of Other sound files

**Playlist:** Display the PlayList



**Play:** Play the selected sound file

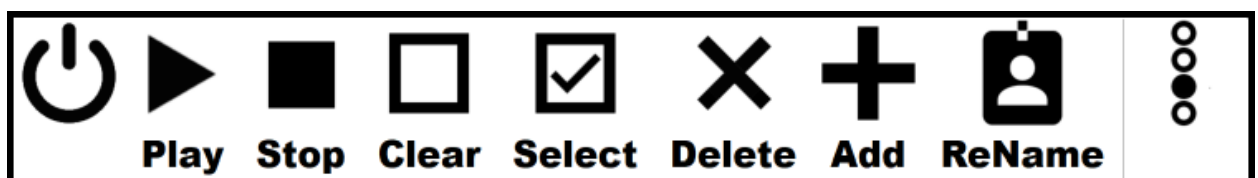
**Stop:** Stop playing

**Louder:** Increase volume

**Softer:** Decrease volume

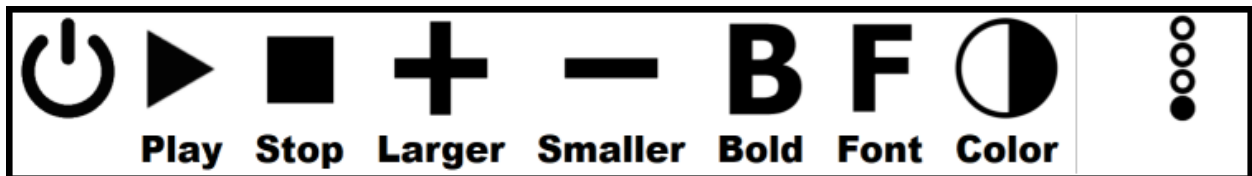
**Mute:** Mute the sound

**Record:** Record the sound coming from the speaker. Used to capture audio when playing videos from YouTube.



**Play:** Play the selected sound file

- Stop:** Stop playing
- Clear:** Clear all “X” selections
- Select:** Put an “X” on the selected sound file (for bulk action)
- Delete:** Delete the sound file
- Add:** Add selected sound file to PlayList
- ReName:** Rename selected sound file



- Play:** Play the selected sound file
- Stop:** Stop playing
- Larger:** Increase the font size
- Smaller:** Decrease the font size
- Bold:** Toggle the text bold attribute
- Font:** Toggle through the 3 default fonts
- Color:** Toggle through the 4 default text/background color pairs
