

EZReader Kindle Application

Kindle allows automatic capturing of text from page images in documents.

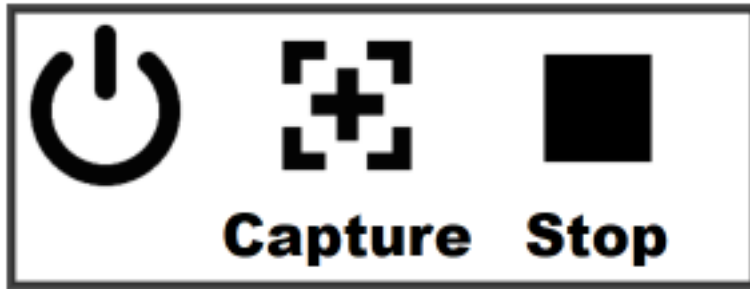
After an image of the current page is captured, Kindle sends a display-next-page command to the document.

The EZReader Kindle app consists of only a toolbar from which the user can import a book from the Amazon Kindle app.

To use the EZReader Kindle app, the user must first use the Amazon Kindle app to open the book. The book should be centered on the desktop and turned to page 1 of the book.

When the EZReader Kindle app Capture icon is press, EZReader will take a picture of the current page in the Amazon Kindle app, use OCR to extract text from the image and then send a message to turn the page.

This continues until the end of the book is reached, at which point the pages of text are merged and placed into the Book Reader Kindle folder. The newly extracted content is given a temporary name, which the user can then change.



- **Capture** - captures an image of each page in the Kindle book
- **Stop** - stop capturing
